Heart - CPCS nourishes caring students by developing their minds and their passion for learning.




Beginning with Children Foundation, Inc.

Founded in 2000 by a group of local parents and Beginning with Children Foundation, Community Partnership Charter School (CPCS) nourishes children's natural intellectual curiosity and inspires them to become self-directed, independent learners. Core subjects -- reading, math, science and social studies -- are integrated into all aspects of the curriculum, which also includes technology, the arts, physical fitness, music and numerous enrichment opportunities.

Parents are our most valuable partners

CPCS engages parents in and out of the classroom. Parents serve as classroom volunteers, event coordinators and members of our dedicated Parent Teacher Community Cooperative (PTCC), Parent Cabinet and school Board of Trustees.

The PTCC provides bi-monthly potluck dinners and educational celebrations for families, including the popular Friday morning Family Reading -- when parents visit their child's class for reading time.

CPCS also offers parent workshops and a Family Creativity Day to promote collaboration with parents.

Expanded opportunities through local partnerships

- Students in grades 1-3 attend a weekly chess class hosted by a Chess-in-the-Schools chessmaster. All students are invited to join the after-school chess club.
- Fourth and fifth graders participate in the JP Morgan Make a Ballet program with the American Ballet Theatre. At the end of each school year, students perform at Lincoln Center.
- NYU students provide classroom support and mentoring.
- Brooklyn-based CAMBA offers a daily after-school program until 6 p.m. and a full-day program during school breaks.
